As part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, the U.S. Department of Energy is providing funding to states and territories to support consumer rebate programs for ENERGY STAR qualified appliances. Under these programs, consumers can receive rebates to purchase energy-efficient appliances when they replace used appliances. Eligibility guidelines, covered products, and rebate amounts differ by state, so consumers should review program requirements carefully.

Rebates are scheduled to begin on December 1, 2009. Rebates may be offered for a limited time only. The rebate program will end when funds run out.

HOW TO APPLY

Consumers can obtain application forms by visiting the program Web site or from participating retailers. Rebates will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis.

Completed applications must be mailed with proof of purchase. Rebates will be issued to consumers as prepaid American Express cards 4 to 8 weeks after receipt of complete application packet.

ELIGIBILITY

All Delaware residents are eligible. Rebates will be limited to two per appliance, per mailing address. Consumers must be replacing an existing appliance to qualify for rebates. The State of Delaware reserves the right to inspect the participants' property to ensure that equipment was installed at the address given.
